5. Have you ever found what you were searching for and still been unsatisfied? What was it?
6. Read John 6:35. What do you do with a statement like that?
7. Does Jesus allow us room to consider Him, simply a “good teacher”?
8. Read John 14:6. What do you do with a statement like that?
9. How does Jesus claim to answer our deepest questions? How does Jesus claim to satisfy our deepest longings? What if all that were true?
10. Jim said, “The only reason to listen to Jesus is if He really did rise from the dead”. Why is that statement true or untrue?
11. Why is it important to base your life on something that is actually true?
12. How is it possible that Jesus who lived 2,000 years ago has anything to do with you today?
13. How would you answer the question, “What are you doing on earth?”?
14. What meaning does your life have, that death will not put an end to?
