Community:

1. What would be the main thing you have learned in this series so far?
2. What has been the most challenging or hard to believe portion of this series so far?

Core:

1. Read John 14:6. Is there any way to read that other than as exclusive? Why is this an offensive verse?
2. If John 14:6 is true, what logical conclusions can you draw from that?
3. When Jim started talking about the “coexist” bumper stickers, what was your emotional reaction? Why?
4. Jim said if what Jesus said about Himself is true, then logically all the other things in the bumper sticker have to be wrong. How do you react to that statement?
5. How does Jesus help us find purpose for our lives and align our priorities?
6. How did Jesus exemplify yielding His will to God’s? Read John 12:49-50.
7. Read John 6:38. What if we did the same thing? How would life look different if we lived everyday the way Jesus did?
8. Jim said, “Most of us have been looking for a god who works for us”. What does that mean? How is that reflected in the way we pray?
9. Jim said, “Broken people call on the name of the Lord and He answers”. Would you rather submit to His will for your life before, during or after being broken?
10. What is one thing in your life right now that you are absolutely certain is not consistent with what God desires for your life?
