Community:

1. What do you like most about living in the information age?
2. What do you like least about living in the information age?

Core:

1. If you were asked prior to this weekend if God speaks to people, what would your answer have been?
2. How do you believe God speaks to people?
3. Do you believe it's possible to know God? Read Acts 17:22-28.
4. In what ways do you see God revealing Himself in nature? Read Psalm 19:1-3
5. Through Jesus? Read John 1:18 and Colossians 1:15
6. Through the Bible? Read 2 Timothy 3:16
7. Read Romans 1:20. Why do you think Paul said that "men are without excuse"?
8. Have you ever made a decision based on something you felt like God told you? How did you know God was telling you?
9. Scott said that if you have a sense that God is telling you to do something the first question you should ask is, "is this consistent with what God has already said?" Why is it important to ask that question?
10. Scott said, that people often use the phrase "God told me" to justify making a terrible decision. Do you agree or disagree?
11. In what ways do you find the Bible to be useful?
12. What does it mean to say that "the Bible is our authority for life"?
13. How has the information in the Bible led to transformation in your life?
14. Have you ever considered that your ability to do what Jesus wants you to do is directly connected with the amount of time you spend listening to what He has to say?
