Weekend Discussion Questions

August 21-22, 2010

Community:

1. Have you entered the world of Apps or do you not care about that technology?

Core:

1. There are lots of messages about sex in our culture. What do people hope to find pursuing sex?
2. In the wrong place, with the wrong person or the wrong venue sex actually delivers the opposite of what was promised. Do you agree with that? Why?
3. Read Proverbs 5:1-2. How do you pay attention to wisdom?
4. Why is sexual immorality different (not worse) than other sin? How are the consequences worse?
5. Read Proverbs 5:15-21. Discuss the metaphor Solomon uses and how it applies to this topic.
6. What difference does Proverbs 5:21 make when dealing with tempting situations?
7. App #1 – “I can’t stop!” – Yes, you can.
 - a. God sees – Galatians 6:7.
 - b. The truth will catch up and come out.
 - c. There will be consequences.
8. App #2 – God sees and understands and knows what you feel and hope to find.
 - a. Hebrews 4:16 – Even though the temptation will not go away God promises to give the strength to make the right decision.
 - b. 1 Corinthians 10:13 – God will provide a way out.
 - c. Run / Flee – Don’t rationalize or minimize the temptation or sin.
 - d. Repent – Run towards God and what he says is good.
9. Jim said that sin kills things and you don’t get to decide who or what gets killed. What do you think about that statement?
10. Is this a graceful and loving message or a hard, outdated one?

Challenge:

1. Memorize Proverbs 5:21, “For a man’s ways are in full view of the LORD, and he examines all his paths.”
2. If you have been dealing with sexual temptation or sin tell someone right away (before you get caught) and run to God and what he says is good.
