### Community:

1. In light of the upcoming Big Questions class, what are your top three questions about the Bible?
2. What is the fiercest storm you have ever been in and how did you survive it?

### Core:

1. Why is a roof so important in the building process of a house and what role does it play for those who live in the house?
2. How do you know what love is?
3. Where have you gotten your definition of love in the past?
4. Read 1 Peter 4:8 and talk about what each of the three parts mean:
  - a. Above all
  - b. Love each other deeply
  - c. Because love covers over a multitude of sins
5. Scott said that love is, “seeking someone else’s good at your own cost”, what does that look like?
6. Read 1 John 3:16 and talk about learning what love is by Jesus example and what we can do to follow Him.
7. “When love is in place it is the protection we need when the storms hit.” Is the roof of your life in place so that you can weather the storms as they come?
8. Love is a decision of the will and we need God, who is love, to help us love others. How do those two statements work together?
