Weekend Discussion Questions

January 9-10, 2010

Community:

1. What is the best thing that you can buy for \$1?
2. What is the best way to invest \$1?

Core:

1. How would you explain “Me Too” to someone who hasn’t been to Flatirons?
2. Jim said that Biblical authority means the Bible is from God, offers a better way to live your life and a better deal to consider. What do you think about that?
3. For the Bible to be authoritative two things need to be true:
 - a. All of the parts of the Bible have to agree
 - b. The context of any of the parts must be understood to know what they mean.
4. Do you think that all of the parts of the Bible do agree?
5. Why do you think that understanding the context is so important?
6. Read Matthew 10:34-39 and talk about the context and what the passage means.
7. Jim said that things will jockey for priority in your life and that most people care more about what others think about them than what God thinks and pleasing him. Have you felt that struggle? What do you do about it?
8. The paradox of the Christian life is that you cannot outdo God. Can you think of an example that demonstrates that paradox?
9. Mother Theresa said, “We can do no great thing, only small things with great love.” What do you think about that?

Challenge:

- 1) Bring a dollar bill to church next weekend in anticipation of making a difference together.
- 2) Walk through your life (house, dorm, apartment, etc.) and try to look at the things in your life differently and in ways that can make a difference for the things that God cares about.
