Community:

1. Have you ever been lost? Describe one of those moments.
2. Have you ever lost something valuable? Describe that moment.

Core:

1. Read Luke 15:1-32. How do these stories answer the original question posed to Jesus?
2. Which story resonates with you the most?
3. Do you identify with being lost, or being found?
4. Have you ever had a moment where you “came to your senses”? What did that look like?
5. Read Luke 19:1-10. Why do you think “everyone” grumbled about Jesus going to Zacchaeus’ house?
6. Who do you have the most trouble forgiving? Why?
7. Read Ephesians 4:32 and ask, are you helping or making it harder for that person to find Jesus?
8. Are you in a place right now where you need to “come to your senses” and turn back to God?
9. Read John 6:66-69. What does this say about how lost things get found?
10. How can we participate in God’s searching for lost and broken people?
