Community:

1. Do you have to answer the phone when it rings? Why?
2. Do you ever experience the "phantom ring"?

Core: Read Psalm 119:25-32 and John 16:33

1. What things in your life do you want to be protected more than anything else?
2. Why are we often surprised when trouble comes?
3. How do you typically respond to interruptions?
4. Jim said, that when the writer of Psalm 119 asks God to preserve his life according to his word, he is asking God to "prop him up". How have you been propped up by God in the past?
5. What if God's instruction doesn't match up to what you feel like doing?
6. What do you believe to be true about God? How should that determine our actions?
7. How do you live in the midst of crisis with hope for the future?
8. Jim said that in the midst of interruptions it's important to 1) ask God for help and 2) choose the way of truth. What does this look like in your life?
9. What two promises do you see in John 16:33?
10. How does the support of a community help you follow God?
