Weekend Discussion Questions

June 13-14, 2009

### Community:

1. What did you expect this series to be about?
2. What do you hope will be covered in this series?

### Core:

1. Jim gave us some ground rules for this series A) Jesus trumps us and B) we need to put into practice what we say we believe. What implications do those ground rules have?
2. Why should what Jesus says trump what we say or believe?
3. How would you define a Christian?
4. Do you remember the 3 legs of the stool that Jim talked about? Why are they each so important?
5. What does it look like to really follow Jesus? (For more on following Jesus check out January 5-6, 2008 message entitled "Resolution".)
6. What does believing in Jesus mean? What does the Bible teach Christians believe about Jesus?
7. What does it mean to say that Christians are "missional"?
8. What are the two potential prisons Christians can find themselves trapped in that Jim covered this weekend? What do separatists or modern day Pharisees say and do? What do syncretists or modern day Sadducees do?
9. Have you had experience in your life with people from either side? What was that like? Have you had a tendency to err on either side?
10. Why is adding to the Bible so dangerous? Why is ignoring or tearing pages out of the Bible so dangerous? What parts of the Bible are you tempted to ignore?
11. Read Colossians 2:8. What hollow and deceptive philosophies are popular in our culture today?
12. How is the church's/Christians' history with alcohol an example of what we talked about this weekend?
13. What is your position on alcohol consumption? How do you explain your position biblically?

2. Memorize Colossians 2:8.
