Community:

1. What is the most controversial subject matter a church could address today?
2. What topics do you think “religious” people like to avoid the most?

Core: Read 1 Corinthians 6 and 7

1. Are you looking for God’s will for your life?
2. Are you open to that being different than what you are hoping?
3. Jim said, “Sexuality is sacred”. What does that mean?
4. In what ways are sexual sins different from all other sins?
5. If you had to say what the Bible teaches about sex in one sentence what would you say?
6. What does the Bible tell us God’s design for sex is?
7. How does the Bible define marriage?
8. What are good Biblical ground rules for what couples can do sexually within their marriage?
9. If you are married are you moving toward greater intimacy with your spouse? If you are single, what are you doing to preserve the intimacy you wish to share with a spouse?
10. Read Matthew 19:4-6. What does this say about God’s desire for us?
11. Why do you think some would say that we shouldn’t talk about these things in church?
12. Why should we talk about these things in church?
13. Is there any part of your life that has higher potential for good or evil than your sexuality?
