Weekend Discussion Questions

June 27-28, 2009

Community:

1. Scott and Jim have been talking about two main ways we fall short as followers of Christ – Not loving God as we should and not loving people the way we should. Which of these two errors do you think is most common today?
2. What is an example of how people do not love God well? What is an example of how people do not love one-another well?
3. Do you know someone who is gay or lesbian? Describe your relationship.

Core:

1. How does your life reflect your freedom in/through Jesus?
2. What is your tendency – to say MORE than the Bible says or to say LESS than the Bible says?
3. Read Romans 1:16-2:4. What are the ramifications when we don't get worship (of God alone) right?
4. Why is it that what comes "Naturally" is not always right? Give an example.
5. What parts of Toby's story resonates with you?
6. How have you typically responded to people who are homosexual? Why?
7. How have you typically responded to people who are heterosexual? Why?
8. What are the options for sexual expression for an unmarried person according to the Bible?
9. Scott gave homework of reading 1 Corinthians, Chapter 7. What does Paul say about being single? Why? What does he say about being married? Why?
10. How does Paul address the situation of a follower of Christ being married to someone who is not a Believer?
11. What does it mean to "show contempt for the riches of His kindness, tolerance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness leads you toward repentance"?
12. Scott mentioned that both last week's message and this week's message are not as much about sex as they are about something else. What have the last two weeks been about fundamentally?
