Core:

1. Read Matthew 25:14-30
2. What are your initial reactions to this story Jesus told?
3. What's the fundamental problem with the third servant's attitude toward the master?
4. What do you know God has entrusted to you? How are you doing with managing that?
5. What are you allowing to keep you from leveraging your talents to make Christ look good in your life?
6. How is the phrase "If it's the LORD's will..." sometimes used as a cop out for doing nothing? Have you ever done this?
7. Would God be a wise manager to entrust you with more right now?
8. Jim said there would be two kinds of reactions to this weekend's teaching. One would be people with hearts beating fast because they want to use what they have for something significant or people with hearts beating fast because they are angry at what he had to say. Which were you? Why?
9. If a stranger observed your life for one month what would they conclude is most important to you? Who would they conclude is most important to you?
10. Is what's most important to you, really important? Is it temporary? Where are you making an eternal impact?
